SANCTUARY FOR NATIVE GAME AT PORTION OF PENTAL ISLAND AND BEVERIDGE ISLAND, NEAR SWAN HILL.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

THE Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, and in pursuance of the provisions of the Game Acts and all other powers me enabling in that behalf, do by this Proclamation direct that the parts of Victoria within the boundaries hereinafter described shall be localities in which, from the first day of January to the thirty-first day of December (both days inclusive) in each year, it shall be unlawful for any person to kill or destroy any native game included in the Third Schedule to the Game Act 1928.

PARTS OF VICTORIA REFERRED TO.

1. Parish of Pental Island, County of Tatchera: Commencing at a point on the southern bank of the Little Murray River directly opposite the south boundary of allotment B, Parish of Pental Island; thence east by a direct line across the said river and the river frontage reserve; and thence continuing east by the south boundary of the said allotment B to the south-east angle of that allotment; thence south-easterly by the south-western boundary of allotment 11, a direct line across a road and the south-western boundary of allotment 12 to the south-eastern angle of that allotment; thence north by the east boundary of the said allotment 12 and a direct line in continuation thereof across the river frontage reserve to the southern bank of the Murray River; thence generally north-westerly by the southern bank of the said Murray River to the northern bank of the Little Murray River at the junction of the said two rivers; thence westerly by a direct line across the mouth of the Little Murray River to its southern bank; thence generally south-easterly by the southern bank of the Little Murray River to the point of commencement. Including all water frontage reserves and all roads within the above-described area.

2. The whole of Beveridge Island, in the Parish of Tyntynder, County of Tatchera.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this nineteenth day of October, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven, and in the first year of the reign of His Majesty King George VI.
